# SAFETY TIPS

## Bicycling Safety Tips in Bend

- Bend is renowned for its scenic beauty and robust cycling culture, drawing riders of all levels to its streets and trails. Whether commuting, exploring Bend's renowned mountain biking routes, or enjoying family rides in local parks, cyclist safety is an essential priority.

- **Essential Safety Tips for Cycling in Bend**

- **Obey Traffic Laws:** In Oregon, bicycles are considered vehicles. Cyclists must follow the same traffic laws as cars—stop at signals, ride in the direction of traffic, and use bike lanes where available.

- **Helmet Use:** Oregon law requires riders under 16 to wear helmets; all ages are strongly advised to wear a properly fitted helmet for maximum protection.

- **Be Visible and Predictable:** Always use a white front light (visible at 500 feet) and a red rear reflector or light for night riding. Wear bright or reflective clothing to increase visibility, and use hand signals to communicate turns or stops.

- **Yield & Share the Road:** Yield to pedestrians, announce when passing ("On your left!"), and never use BMX tricks or ride hands-free on public roads.



- **Positioning and Single File Riding:** Stay in the bike lane when available, ride single file when in a group, and avoid the blind spots of vehicles—especially at intersections.

- **Roundabout Navigation:** When approaching a roundabout, choose to either ride as a vehicle (merging and signaling correctly) or dismount and cross as a pedestrian.

- **Monitor Speed and Trail Use:** Maintain control, ride at safe speeds, and respect one-direction trails in Bend's parks. Uphill riders have right-of-way on trails, and cyclists should always be alert for others.

- **Bike and Equipment Maintenance:** Regularly check brakes, tire pressure, gears, and lights. Carry a small repair and emergency kit for unexpected issues.

- **E-Bike Rules:** Electric-assist bikes are welcome on most trails in Bend but must not exceed 1,000 watts or speeds higher than 20 mph on level ground.
