SUMMER SAFETY TIPS

Tips for Safe BBQ'ing and Outdoor Heat Lamp Use

With summer in full swing at Cascade Village, many residents are excited to fire up their BBQ grills and enjoy cozy evenings outdoors with newly introduced propane heat lamps. To ensure that your gatherings are both fun and safe, here are some essential safety tips.

BBQ Safety Tips

- Inspect your grill for leaks, cracks, or blockages before use. Pay special attention to hoses and connections on gas grills.
- Always grill outside, at least 10 feet away from your house, garage, or trees. Never use grills in enclosed spaces, such as garages or on balconies.
- Use your grill on a flat, non-flammable surface, such as concrete or asphalt.
- If using the BBQ grill at the Cascade Village Clubhouse, please follow the rules and guidelines posted in the area to ensure a safe and pleasant experience for all residents.
- Keep a fire extinguisher or a garden hose nearby in case of emergencies.
- Never leave your grill unattended while in use. Establish a safety zone to keep children and pets away.
- Use long-handled tools and avoid wearing loose clothing that could catch fire.
- For charcoal grills, only use approved starter fluids—never gasoline. Move the fluid container away from the grill before lighting the coals.
- Clean your grill before each use and separate raw meats from other foods to avoid cross-contamination.

- Use a food thermometer to ensure meats reach safe internal temperatures (145°F for whole cuts, 160°F for ground meats, and 165°F for poultry).

Outdoor Heat Lamp Safety Tips

- Ensure you are using quality propane heat lamps designed for outdoor use, complete with sturdy guards to prevent contact with flammable materials.
- Secure propane heat lamps to ensure they cannot tip or fall, and always place them on a stable, flat surface.
- Maintain a distance of at least 18 inches from anything flammable and ensure they are positioned at least 20 inches from people or pets.
- Never use a propane heat lamp overnight or when it cannot be monitored. Always turn them off and disconnect the propane supply when not in use.
- Check the propane tank, hoses, and connections for leaks before use. If you detect any gas smell, do not light the lamp and ventilate the area immediately.
- Regularly inspect heat lamp connections for damage and also ensure the area around the lamp is clean and free of dust or debris.
- Make sure that you have a fire extinguisher nearby while using propane heat lamps.

Preventing Sun Stroke at Cascade Village: Summer & Poolside Best Practices

Understanding Sun Stroke

Sun stroke (heat stroke) is a serious condition where the body overheats, often due to prolonged sun exposure or physical activity in high temperatures. It can cause organ damage or even be life-threatening if not treated promptly.

10 Key Prevention Tips for Cascade Village Residents and Visitors

1. Stay Hydrated

- Drink plenty of water throughout the day, especially when outdoors or swimming. Sports drinks can help replace lost electrolytes, but avoid excessive caffeine or alcohol as they can dehydrate you.

2. Dress Smart

- Wear loose-fitting, lightweight, and light-colored clothing—cotton and linen are ideal for keeping cool. A wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses protect your head and eyes from direct sun.

3. Apply Sunscreen

- Use a broad-spectrum sunscreen with at least SPF 30. Apply generously 15 minutes before going outside and reapply every two hours, or more often if you're swimming or sweating.

4. Plan Activities Wisely

- Avoid outdoor or poolside activities during peak heat. Schedule exercise and swimming in the early morning or late afternoon when it's cooler.

5. Take Breaks in the Shade

- Rest frequently in shaded or air-conditioned areas. Use umbrellas, canopies, or shaded poolside spots to limit direct sun exposure.

6. Know Your Medications

- Some medicines increase heat sensitivity or dehydration risk. Consult your healthcare provider if you're taking medications and plan to be in the sun.

7. Never Leave Anyone or Sit in a Parked Car

- Temperatures inside cars can rise dangerously fast, even with windows cracked. Always check your vehicle and keep it locked when parked.

8. Acclimate to the Heat

- Gradually increase your time outdoors to let your body adjust to higher temperatures, especially if you're new to summer activities or just arrived at Cascade Village.


9. Poolside Best Practices

- Reapply sunscreen after swimming.
- Drink water before, during, and after pool time.


